The admission route is governed by the Tamil Nadu Engineering Admissions (TNEA) process, which mandates a split of 65% for the Government quota and 35% for the Management quota.

Transport and Connectivity JNNIE maintains a transport network to assist with student and staff commuting. The campus is located on the Chennai–Periyapalayam Highway. The nearest major rail link is the Ponneri railway station, located approximately 18 kilometers from the campus.

In addition to physical infrastructure, the college facilitates access to government-mandated financial support systems.
