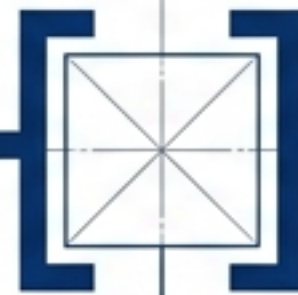

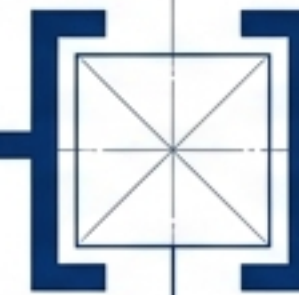
Establishment of the college. Initial undergraduate programmes launched: Computer Science and Engineering, Electronics and Communication Engineering, and Information Technology.
