Separate hostel blocks available for both boys and girls.

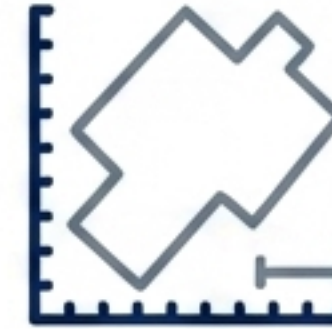


## Transport & Connectivity
