For TNEA 2026 aspirants, this means admission is conducted through a 100% university quota with no management seats available. This classification ensures that students are governed by the rigorous academic standards of Anna University, Chennai, while benefiting from the infrastructure of a large-scale regional campus.

The institution's foundational strengths date back to its establishment in 1999 by the Government of Tamil Nadu. Originally part of the Bharathidasan Institute of Technology, it has since transitioned into a cornerstone of the Anna University system. Its evolution into a TEQIP-II supported institution—a World Bank-assisted program—highlights its capacity for high-level technical development. The campus is formally recognized under UGC sections 2(f) and 12(B), a status that confirms its eligibility for central funding and validates its academic credibility.

The institution's mission is: "transforming students into responsible citizens and competent professionals; imparting education that meets societal and professional needs; nurturing innovation and research; upholding professional ethics, transparency, accountability, teamwork, and entrepreneurial skills."

Institutional Milestones:

- **TEQIP-II Status:** Selected for the World Bank-assisted Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme.

4. Undergraduate Degree Programs (B.E. / B.Tech)

The BIT Campus is a unique "multi-disciplinary hub" within the TNEA system. While most constituent colleges focus on a narrow set of core branches, AUBIT offers an expansive curriculum of 18 branches. This diversity allows for interdisciplinary collaboration between students in traditional fields and those in highly specialized sectors like Petrochemicals and AI—a rare advantage for a government-run institution. The total approved intake is 1260 seats.

5. Residential Infrastructure and Student Housing

Providing a stable living environment is essential for a regional hub like Tiruchirappalli, which attracts talent from across Tamil Nadu. The BIT Campus offers significant on-campus housing, which is critical for students coming from outside the Srirangam region. The residential units are overseen by a structured administrative team to ensure student safety and welfare.

- **Boys' Hostels:** Four dedicated buildings with an approximate capacity of 1300 students.
- **Girls' Hostels:** Three dedicated buildings with an approximate capacity of 1200 students.
- **Administrative Oversight:** Managed by an independent unit comprising a Warden, Executive Warden, and multiple Deputy Wardens.
- **Student Support:** Residential Tutors live on-site to provide immediate academic and administrative guidance.

Access to these facilities is made equitable through a comprehensive suite of financial aid programs for eligible candidates.

6. Scholarships and Financial Access

For TNEA candidates, scholarships are a vital bridge to accessing a top-tier Anna University education. The BIT Campus facilitates a wide array of state and central government schemes, ensuring that financial constraints do not hinder meritorious students.

The following schemes are **available to eligible students at this institution:**

- **SC / ST Scholarship:** Administered by the Government of Tamil Nadu for Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe students.
- **BC / MBC / DNC Scholarship:** Provided by the Government of Tamil Nadu for Backward Class, Most Backward Class, and Denotified Community students.
- **First Graduate Scholarship:** Available for first-generation graduates admitted via TNEA.
- **Post-Matric Scholarship (OBC):** A central sector scheme from the Government of India for OBC students based on income criteria.
- **Minority Scholarships:** Pre-matric and Post-matric schemes administered by the Ministry of Minority Affairs.

The BIT Campus is a research-intensive environment, evidenced by its TEQIP-II status and a cumulative research funding of approximately ₹300 million from bodies like DST and AICTE. Notably, the campus houses **two dedicated research centers** specifically funded by these national agencies.

The institution reports a **self-declared placement rate of 80 percent**, with students frequently securing positions in major IT, Pharma, and Core Engineering firms. Graduates also excel in higher education, with many securing M.Tech admissions at **IIT Guwahati, IIT Kharagpur, IIT Kanpur, IIT Hyderabad, and NIT Trichy**, as well as international destinations like the **University of Edinburgh and Nottingham University**.
