Note on Minority Status: While the college is managed by the CSI Thoothukudi-Nazareth Diocese (a minority body), it has not claimed statutory minority status for TNEA 2026 admission purposes. Consequently, admissions follow the standard 65% Government quota and 35% Management quota split, with no specific minority reservation through the single-window counseling process.

This administrative clarity serves as the gateway to understanding the institution's deep-rooted educational heritage.

2. Institutional Heritage and Founding Mission

A college's "Founding Story" is a vital indicator of its long-term stability and the values that shape its campus culture. For GUPCE, its legacy is tied to a mission of community service and regional development, providing a stable environment for academic pursuit.

Established in 2002, the college is managed by the Church of South India (CSI) Thoothukudi-Nazareth Diocese. It is named in honor of the Reverend Dr. George Uglow Pope (1820–1908), the celebrated British scholar who famously translated the *Thirukkural* into English. His devotion to Tamil literature and education remains the motivating force behind the institution. The college was founded to provide high-quality technical education to the Thoothukudi region, a mission currently overseen by the Correspondent, Thiru. R. Rajesh Ravi Chandar, and the Principal, Dr. J. Japhynth.

With a firm foundation in regional service, the college maintains rigorous adherence to national regulatory standards.
