2. Founding and Institutional Heritage

An institution's founding legacy and its historical stability are critical metrics for regional reputation. A history spanning nearly seven decades indicates institutional maturity, often resulting in a vast and influential alumni network that directly benefits current graduates.

Thiagarajar College of Engineering was established in 1957 by the industrialist and philanthropist Shri Karumuttu Thiagarajan Chettiar, managed by the Kalaithanthai Karumuttu

Thiagaraja Chettiar Memorial Charitable Trust. The institution's growth reflects the industrial evolution of India. While established in 1957, it introduced the foundational core branches—Civil, Mechanical, and Electrical Engineering—in 1958. As technology pivoted toward the digital age, the college expanded into Electronics and Communication in 1978 and Computer Science in 1984.

A critical milestone occurred in 1987 when the college was granted Autonomous status. This allowed the institution to move beyond standard university templates and innovate its own pedagogical methods. Today, this historical growth supports a highly regulated yet academically agile environment.

3. NAAC Accreditation Status

NAAC grades serve as the most reliable objective benchmark for parents to evaluate the internal quality of an institution's teaching, infrastructure, and governance. A high grade is a verification of the college's commitment to academic standards.

Thiagarajar College of Engineering currently holds a prestigious **A++ Grade** from its NAAC Cycle 2 accreditation, achieved in 2024. The college secured a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of **3.56 out of 4.00**. This accreditation is currently valid for the 2026 admissions cycle, signaling that the institution operates at the highest tier of quality benchmarks in India. These quality indicators are further validated by consistent performance in national ranking frameworks.

6. Faculty Profile

There is a direct correlation between the density of PhD-qualified faculty and the quality of academic mentorship. High-level qualifications usually translate to better classroom delivery and stronger support for student projects.

Based on NIRF 2024 data, TCE employs a dedicated team of **213 faculty members**. A very high proportion of the regular faculty hold PhDs, ensuring that students are taught by experts who contribute to their respective fields of research. This intellectual depth fosters an environment that moves beyond rote learning into practical application, supported by the college's physical infrastructure.

7. Campus Infrastructure and Residential Facilities

A robust physical environment is essential for holistic student development. On-campus housing facilitates a collaborative culture and allows students to maximize their time in labs and seminars.

The TCE campus spans **143 acres** in Madurai, providing a sprawling environment for academic and co-curricular pursuits. Key residential and academic facilities include:

- **Hostels:** Dedicated TCE Men's Hostel and TCE Ladies Hostel.
- **Infrastructure:** An indoor stadium, open-air auditorium, and the KS and KM seminar halls.
- **Laboratories:** Specialized departmental laboratories equipped for modern technical training.

For students not residing on campus, the college maintains a high level of accessibility through localized transport hubs and city-wide bus connectivity, specifically serving the Thiruparankundram area.

8. Transport and Connectivity

Logistical ease is a vital consideration for day scholars and visiting parents. Reliable connectivity ensures that a student's focus remains on academic performance rather than a difficult commute.

The college is located in **Thiruparankundram**, on the outskirts of Madurai. It is efficiently served by city bus connectivity with dedicated stops for the institution. For regional and national travelers, **Madurai Junction** is the nearest major railhead, ensuring the campus is easily reachable from across the state. This logistical accessibility is paired with financial support systems to ensure equitable access.

9. Scholarships and Financial Access

State and institutional financial aid programs are essential for ensuring that high-quality engineering education remains accessible to all meritorious students, regardless of economic background.

Eligible students at TCE can access several financial aid streams:

- **TN Social Justice Scholarships:** Targeted at SC/ST, BC, MBC, and DNC categories.
- **National Scholarships:** Central government schemes available via the national portal.
- **Institutional & Alumni Initiatives:** Merit-cum-means scholarships supported by the college's active alumni base.

These support structures facilitate the strong career outcomes and placements that define the institution's success.

10. Placement Performance and Career Outcomes

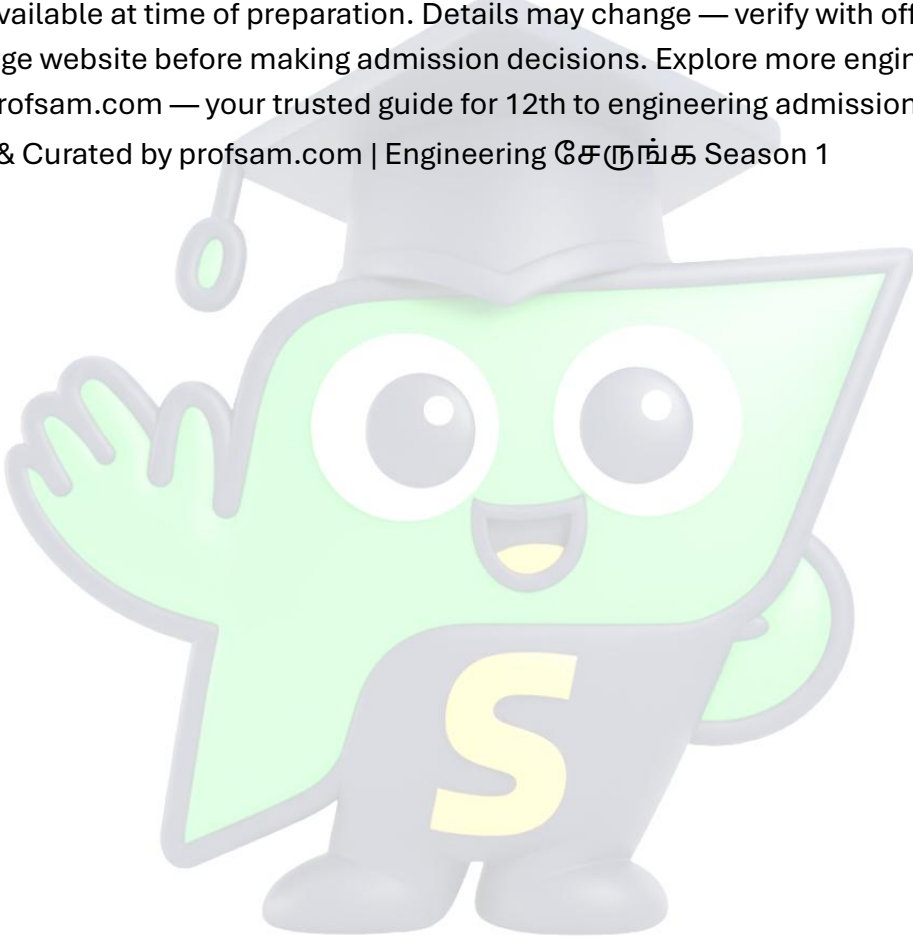
12. Institutional Achievements and Distinctions
